NEW LEADER FOR DUKE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL DEVELOPMENT OFFICE

DURHAM, N.C. (Nov. 1, 2008) — Duke Children's Hospital & Health Center has selected Susan Glenn as its new executive director of development. Susan assumes her role Nov. 1.

Susan Glenn has been a fundraising professional for more than 18 years. Prior to joining Duke Children's, she led many fundraising efforts and teams in medical and academic settings.

"I am so excited about what lies ahead for Duke Children's and pleased to be a part of it," Susan said.

Prior to coming to Duke, she served as the Executive Development Officer of the Advocate Health Care System in Chicago. She was responsible for the major gift fundraising program at eight hospitals, ultimately raising \$125 million in campaign contributions. Susan started her fundraising career as the Director of the Annual Programs at Silver Cross Hospital in 1990. In 1995, she became the Executive Director of Development at Lewis University and developed and implemented the University's first-ever \$30 million Capital Campaign. In 1998, she had the opportunity to develop a major gift program at her alma mater, Northern Illinois University, where she received her degree in Corporate Communications.

In 2004 Susan relocated to North Carolina from Chicago to get married and start a family. She currently resides in Hillsborough with her husband Bennie and four-year-old daughter Skyler.
